

Minutes of the Church Fair Table Chairs Meeting September 29, 2019

-Barb will have signup sheets available for each table in early October.

-We will be partnering with St James this year. They will join us on Friday night and have a table in Fellowship Hall (see below). They have offered us a table at their fair on Saturday. Their fair runs from 9-2. We briefly discussed stocking our table with a sampling of items, perhaps some Good Finds, Country Store items including a few apple and chicken pot pies (and maybe some cookies?). We will need to find someone to staff the table at St James.

-Barb is still working on figuring table locations but in general should be same as last year. Jewelry will be on the stage. Good Finds will have at least as much space as last year, possibly a bit more. There is no Grandpa's Workshop this year. The plan is for St James to have a table where Grandpa's Workshop is usually located (on left immediately as you walk into Fellowship Hall) for Friday night. On Saturday we will fill the space with a combined craft and garden table. Barb is considering taking charge of this table.

-Nancy asked when the stage would be cleared for jewelry sorting/set-up. There is space available in Memorial Hall which can be used until the stage is cleared. Barb also mentioned the need to get the fair boxes out of the thrift shop as well as the Good Find items upstairs. We will need to coordinate through the church office to find a convenient time when Perry Park Preschool is not in session.

-We will be renting a 30x30 tent in order to allow more vendors to participate in the fair. The tent will be set up in the parking lot by the Perry Park play yard. The tent will have lights and heat. We will lose a few parking spots but hope the additional vendors will bring more people to the fair.

-Freezer space will be in demand for apple pies and chicken pot pies. Susan suggested selling other frozen meals since the pot pies were successful. She is going to try lasagna and Kim is experimenting with shepherd's pie. We might need to ask the congregation if they have any available freezer space we could use leading up to the fair. During the fair we might need to make use of coolers to keep everything frozen.

-Now is the time for all table chairs to get information to Jen for the bulletin and email. Let the congregation know what your needs are and how they can help make the Snowflake Fair a success!
