I wanted to live deep and suck out all the marrow of life, to live so sturdily and Spartan-like as to put to rout all that was not life, to cut a broad swath and shave close, to drive life into a corner, and reduce it to its lowest terms... Well here we are, beginning our last year together. Before you know it, the time to say goodbye will be upon us. I think the greatest gift we could give to one another is the gift a great goodbye. I know that GCC has had rocky relationships with pastors in the past, and that saying goodbye has been problematic and even muted at times. We have known from the start that my time with you was limited, that I would only walk with you a short way. Saying goodbye means that when our instincts say to pull away we draw close; saying goodbye means that when our instincts say not to say something, or just to wait, we take action. Saying goodbye means we celebrate our time and our ministry together. I have picked Sunday, June 21, 2020 as a day of celebration, a day when will come together to celebrate the journey we have taken together, when we will offer forgiveness for the mistakes we have made and for the undone work. A day when we will bless one another for the road ahead. That June day is coming, that day is inevitable. As we walk towards that day, I want to take the words of Thoreau to heart, to suck the marrow from life, to savor and delight in the time we have celebrating the amazing ministry of this church, about marveling at the Saints we have walking in our midst, and trusting that God is not done with our Church.

The word "jubilee" comes from the Hebrew word **jobel**, which means "ram's horn". It was the ram's horn that was used to trumpet in the beginning of the jubilee year. Jubilee was a year of forgiving debts, returning land, a year returning and re-centering life around God. A year of jubilee is a year feasts and celebrations that fill us with joy despite our hardships and allow gratitude and hope to fill us anew.

This is why I am suggesting that between September and June we celebrate the year of Jubilee, picking a Sunday for the numerous ministries of our church and recognizing them and celebrating. In December I will celebrate 10 years of ordained ministry, and the ministers and shepherds have assured me that there will be a party that day for sure. The thing about Jubilee though is it not just celebration and joy, it's also a year of confession and forgiveness, otherwise it's shallow and meaningless. It means being real about who and where we are as individuals and as a church. Let us fill this last year together with Jubilee both confessing our brokenness and celebrating God's ongoing work in our lives.




